Anjan, who was a doctoral student at IIM-Calcutta at the time of his fellowship, told us that "the fellowship helped me decide on the case method as the core of my research career." He is now an associate professor of strategic management at the Narxoz Business School in Kazakhstan, where he founded and directs the Silk Road Case Center. "We have a growing need for teaching cases on businesses in Central Asia," Anjan reported. "The young generation who are poised to lead must understand the local business context. 
Nermeen Shehata ('17)
